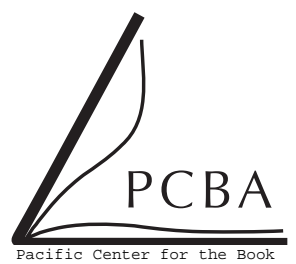


2008 Book Arts and Printers' Fair



Dear PCBA member:

It's that time of year again! The 2008 Book Arts and Printers' Fair will be held on Saturday, May 10 at Fort Mason Center in San Francisco. This is one of the greatest PCBA events of the year— a chance to catch up with PCBA pals, check out what other folks have been working on and pump some money into our vibrant Bay Area book arts economy!

This year, we'll have both exhibition rooms again, and will also have the small room where members can sign up to give more in-depth demonstrations or mini-workshops throughout the day.

If you're exhibiting:

- o We can only accept written reservation requests, accompanied by a check. Tables will be reserved on a first come, first served basis. The deadline is **April 2nd** (*if your entry arrives late, it will not be opened until after April 23rd*), but don't wait, as we usually sell out.
- o Table assignments will be made randomly again this year, with an attempt to spread vendors of similar items across the space. You cannot, and should not, count on having the same space you had last year. Since some people prefer the small room, and others prefer to avoid it, *we will honor requests from any vendors who were in the small room last year to be in the big room this year.*
- o Fort Mason raised prices this year, so we have too, but only by a little bit. Make checks payable to Pacific Center for the Book Arts, with the memo stating: 2008 Printers' Fair, and send it with the form on the back to: Heidi Hess, 616 Guerrero Street, SF, CA 94110. - o If you're not sure you even need a half-table, and would like us to help connect you with other members who might want to share, please try out the PCBA Table Matchmaking Service!
- o You will receive email confirmation of your table by April 10th. *If your entry arrives after April 2nd, it will not get opened until after April 23rd, so you will not receive confirmation until April 28th.*

If you're interested in doing a demo or workshop:

People really enjoyed these workshops last year. We're hoping to expand the offerings, so please let us know if you're interested in taking a half-hour or an hour to share something with the PCBA community and other Printers' Fair visitors. The space will be free for folks giving the demos, and the workshops should be free for folks attending (though if you want to charge small materials fee, you can).
